<i>FEMCAT</i> <i>In English: "Let's Do Cat (alonia)"</i>	<i>Foundation</i>	Created in 2004 with the aim to bring together entrepreneurs, executives and professionals with a common goal: to conduct and support initiatives that serve the progress of Catalan society and to turn Catalonia as one of the leading countries in Europe and in the world, socially and economically.
<i>CECOT</i> <i>In English: Terrassa's Regional Business Confederation</i>	Employers' organization	Created in 1978, it represents eight thousand entrepreneurs (as of November 2013) and includes 38 professional associations in Catalonia.
<i>PIMEC</i> <i>In English: Small and Medium Enterprises of Catalonia</i>	Employers' organization	Formed by the union of several employers in the late seventies of last century, it was born with the aim to defend and represent the interests of small and medium enterprises and have presence in every forum of consultation and debate, at all levels: in Catalonia, Spain and Europe (through UEAPME-EU Craft and Small and Medium Enterprises).
